

**CORE NIAT P86M** -60% YoY


- A significant portion of Medilines' business is project-based.
- Decline in revenues and NIAT is due mainly to non-readiness of sites.
- Php 1B worth of projects pushed forward to 2024. Php 400M already invoiced in Q1 2024.







**Cancer Therapy**
